The **Cooke Summer Academy (CSA)** is designed to reinforce academic and social skills developed in classrooms during the school year. Students participate in a small group, multi-sensory, thematic based learning environment with integrated related services including speech and language therapy, counseling, physical therapy, and occupational therapy. Students are grouped based on differentiated learning profiles and are assessed continuously throughout the six week program.
