

ADAPTIVE Skills

Developmentally-appropriate lessons to strengthen skills for **daily living** are essential for our students to effectively navigate their homes, workplaces, and communities. As independence increases from early childhood through adulthood, these skills may include **basic self-care**, **travel training** (using mass transportation), **grocery shopping** (following a grocery list), **preparing meals** (using measuring tools) and **managing money** (opening a bank account).

SELF Advocacy

Cooke's **post-21 Alumni Services** includes a partnership with **SDMNY** (Supported Decision Making NY). A less restrictive alternative to guardianship, SDMNY **promotes autonomy** for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities, empowering them to take an active role in making choices about their own lives. In this program, Cooke students and alumni develop self-advocacy skills to make their own decisions and enlist the help of others to support their decision making.
